

# Eternal Security

## Romans 5:1-11

*In Romans 5, Paul tells us that we are bound eternally to an infinite loving God.*

**Here are 6 links of the Chain of truth that binds us to that Eternal God**

### 1. The Believers \_\_\_\_\_ with God (5:1)

- A. "Therefore" connects whatever it was that Paul was talking about before this statement.
- B. What was he talking about? Being \_\_\_\_\_ by faith, we have peace with God.
- C. Apart from Salvation, every human being is at \_\_\_\_\_ with God.
- D. There is no \_\_\_\_\_. Either you are with Him or against Him. And He you.

### 2. The Believers Standing in \_\_\_\_\_ (5:2a)

- A. For Jews, the idea of having \_\_\_\_\_ "access" to God was unthinkable. It is only used 3 times in the NT.
- B. We are not saved by divine \_\_\_\_\_ & then preserved by \_\_\_\_\_ effort.

### 3. The Believers \_\_\_\_\_ of Glory (2b -5a)

- A. Since every aspect of salvation is solely the work of God, then salvation cannot possibly be \_\_\_\_\_.
- B. Jesus is our HOPE! (1Tim 1:1)
- C. Hebrews 6 says that God holds onto us so that we can hold onto Him.

### 4. The Believers Possession of Divine \_\_\_\_\_ (5:5b-8)

- A. When a person receives salvation he enters into a love \_\_\_\_\_ with God that will last all of eternity.
- B. Remember this "Love of God" is His love towards you not your love for Him
- C. It's interesting to see the word "\_\_\_\_\_" - it gives the feel of giving it all, not holding back, received quickly. It is not measured, it is poured out overflowing.

### 5. The Believers Certainty of \_\_\_\_\_ (5:9-10)

- A. But Wait... There is more... Infomercial
- B. Justified by His Blood refers to the initial aspect of Salvation which is in the \_\_\_\_\_.
- C. Because we ID with Christ now, & are adopted into God's family, we are no longer "Children Of \_\_\_\_\_" (Eph. 2:3)

### 6. The Believers \_\_\_\_\_ in God (5:11)

- A. Maybe David was a man after God's own heart, b/c he \_\_\_\_\_ over his God.
- B. We should be singing and dancing and praising this God that has given more than we can receive. Our cup truly \_\_\_\_\_.
