Hebrews 6:4–8

False Security

The book of Hebrews is lovingly exposing this dangerous happiness and warning us to flee from its deceptions and pursue the solid happiness in Christ. Therefore, Hebrews is written to deepen and strengthen the joy of our assurance in God.

1. There are great \_\_\_\_\_ and high religious \_\_\_\_\_ (vs 4–5).
  - A. May have been \_\_\_\_\_ (verse 4).
  - B. May have become a \_\_\_\_\_ of the Holy Spirit (vs 4).
  - C. May have tasted the \_\_\_\_\_ of God (vs 5).
  - D. May have tasted the \_\_\_\_\_ of the age to come (vs 5;).
  - E. Because you had an \_\_\_\_\_, does not mean you're a child of God.

## 2. In spite of these blessing /experience, he/she then falls away (vs 6).

1. Consider vss 7–8. – A watered \_\_\_\_\_
2. Consider vs 9. But, beloved, we are convinced of \_\_\_\_\_.
3. Consider Hebrews 3:14 (and 3:6). "We have become partakers of Christ." Not we "will become partakers" but "we have become \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ"
4. Consider Hebrews 13:20–21. -- Salvation isn't dependent on us. Salvation is \_\_\_\_\_ on God."

**Conclusion:** - Enter your relationship with God as if your life depended on it. Because, quite honestly it does. Your Eternal Life depends on your relationship with Christ.
